After prayerful consideration and in honour of the safety of all of us, I have recommended to the Executive Team, and they have agreed, to suspend all church activities through to March 31, 2020 at the earliest. There will be no meetings or gatherings of any of the regular groups, meetings, or worship services. This includes:

- Thrift Shop; and
- Worship

The church office will remain open for the time being. We gather as people of God knowing that the church is more than the building; we will continue to find ways to be together.

There is now a phone tree in place for communication to spread quickly and easily through the community of Jubilee, and we as your Leadership Team will continue to monitor and communicate as we can.

We will be exploring opportunities for virtual worship and gatherings to occur, and as that becomes clearer, we will determine how to share that information.
