The Executive Team joined together via Zoom, a platform that allowed all members to communicate with one another at the same time.

OPENING PRAYER

The extraordinary meeting began with prayer at 6:30 pm.

Rev. Graham sent an email prior to the meeting with information about a request for using our location as a cold-weather shelter. Jubilee United Church is not expected to run the shelter, the request is just for a location as well as a liaison for any issues that may arise around the facility during this time. Everything else including insurance is taken care of by the requesting agencies. There is an expectation of a meal program, but there is good possibility that other churches in the area can also participate. Union Gospel Mission will help to coordinate this. There are two options:

- (1) Nightly shelter that runs from 7:30 pm to 7:30 am which will be organized and facilitated by Progressive Housing Society
- (2) Emergency weather response shelter – a decision is made by 11:00 am if the shelter needs to be open if there is a cold weather advisory. This is organized and facilitated by Lookout Emergency Aid Society.

Katy Jang has volunteered to be the liaison for Jubilee United. A number of volunteers have already submitted their names to assist during this time.

MOTION: That Jubilee United Church, with the support of related agencies, will proceed with the proposal for the use of our church hall as a nightly cold weather shelter.
